Membership


Collaborative membership comprises individuals and representatives of organizations with an interest in housing. Members contribute to the group's administrative and advocacy direction via a consensus-driven model. Members contribute to meeting discussions, bring forward learning opportunities to the group, set priorities and collaborate with each other.



Coordinating Team

As its governing body, the Coordinating Team oversees the organization's affairs on behalf of membership. The team may create standing committees to help conduct business. Standing Committees include Governance, Nominating & Finance Committee.







Work Groups

Work groups report directly to the membership and may serve in ad hoc capacities and consist of members generally engaging around community level outcomes. Among prior work groups have been Advocacy, Housing Plan, Housing Land Bank State Bill, and City of Houston Building Codes.



Executive Director & Staff

Primary staff responsibilities are to bring together key stakeholders to build consensus. The executive director is the point of contact for all groups in the Collaborative and ensures that they communicate with each other.
